

*Hugo Uruguay...and I'll Go Mine* or *The Mystery of the Tarragon Plum* describes the exploits of Hugo Uruguay, a teenage Nancy Drew detective, as she proceeds to unravel the sudden, inexplicable transformation of buildings into cakes, candy bars and other dessert varieties. The historical figures of Medusa, Joan of Arc, Glinda the Good and Cleopatra break the time barrier to offer their assistance, while the real search continues for whomever is creating the sinister tarragon plum.

*Uh-Oh Susanna!* or *Westward Ho the Pennywhistles* explores a widow's journey across the country to San Francisco following the sudden death of her husband, accompanied by her eight children, Kate, Polly, Dolly, Molly, Holly, Sally, Blaine and Duane. Along the way, they encounter outlaws, Indians and gypsies.

*Robyn Hood and her Merry Maids* finds an 80's computer nerd and the infamous Robyn (yes, related to her Sherwood Forest namesake) caught in a time warp created by a computer program. She is thrust forward through time into Taddie's world while he is hurled backwards to the medieval era, where no one understands his computer lingo. The adventure continues they desperately explore avenues to return to their appropriate time zones.
